Here are the major highlights of the past few months.

Matters for praise:

- my fellow worker, **Sanyi has found his spouse** (standing next to him to his right)! She seems to be ready to commit her life to him and to the Gypsies among whom he lives and serves full-time. What an amazing gift from the Lord! And what a boost for his life and ministry...!



- By God's special grace **Miki** (see above, to the left) a former **"heavy weight" criminal, gang leader and drog dealer got converted** a couple of weeks ago (Sanyi's been faithfully discipling him) and has just **married** Evi (to his left, the woman he's been living with) today!



If Miki becomes a truly committed believer he will be a powerful evangelist among his former friend from the criminal world. That's what he feels God is calling him to do. May it be so! Would you please pray for him earnestly, especially for his ongoing spiritual and existential struggles.

- Akos, another one of our disciples has been in prison for a crime he committed 9 years ago, well before he got saved. It was a sorrow to say goodbye to him 6 months ago when he went in, originally for 9 months, but by God's special and miraculous intervention he was released well before the 9th month.



When the judge pronounced him guilty and sent him into prison for 9 months he added "Not even God could change this final verdict!" And yes He did change it! He brought him out 3 months before the original time overriding the court's decision of a closed case. We still cannot believe it. What's more, one of Akos's cell mates got saved having seen Akos's faith and his life testimony. And now he is seriously considering to join the prison ministry group that was visiting him while he was in prison.

He also wants to marry Livi (see below), her girlfriend and faithful partner for so many years!



As you may remember he is the one whom God miraculously saved from an almost fatal car accident 9 years ago (see his car below).



- after years of teaching OT at Sonship Academy I was given the opportunity to teach the NT as well, focusing on the Gospels. I am excited. How could you not be excited when you can spend a whole day/course with the life of Jesus!
- a **big stock of firewood has just arrived** even though hardly anyone is able get firewood this winter due to the economic crisis and the huge demand. It is a miracle. We still don't know how we made it right to the top of the waiting list with our request. It's a miracle. May the Lord give wisdom to us for a wise distribution among the designated families (orphans and widows) in need.



- Since our kids are back at school/kindergarten **Timi** was able to reconnect with women during the day and they started a **weekly Women's Bible study** group in one of the villages (no picture yet, sorry).

Matters for prayer:

- a **heavily bound Roma lady** by Satan (Mini) is **getting close to complete freedom** (honestly hoping) as we have been ministering to her in a very special way for 8 years now. We have learned many precious things about deliverance, inner healing, Jesus' immesurable power and the schemes of

the enemy. Please continue to pray for her for endurance and for finishing well! and for special protection from the deception of the enemy. What makes it especially harder to proceed with her is that **she had to move out of her protected home/environment** at the beginning of September and she **has been having trouble finding a job** ever since.

- our hearts are broken, **one of my best friends died** (at age 44) a week ago due to a tragic accident during construction. A huge pile of bricks crushed his chest. We don't know what to say. Unbelievable. Unbearable... This is now a heavy spiritual burden and a very deep faith struggle for so many of us. I don't understand why God took him away from his family (loving wife and 2 dumb and mute children!) my **mother-in-law got her finger torn off** a few days ago as she was doing physical exercises! Horrible. Would you please pray for a speedy recovery for her! She is moving to us for some time until she recovers from this accident.
- the **war situation** in the neighborhood remains to be unsettling and a constant matter for prayer. It's good to know that our Lord is in control. Please continue to pray for an end to the war and for many to come to know God's provision, love and grace, as His servants, like a friend's friend, a Ukranian chaplain, continue to serve those who's lives have been changed by the war.
