4. Continue to thank God for the various ministries of the Presbyterian Church in India, like preaching of the gospel, raising our children to **love** Jesus (Sunday School Programs), training church leaders, ministry to the poor, orphans, displaced men and women, etc.
5. Continue to thank God for his enabling grace to love him and serve him over the years. Pray for us that we will be able to visit churches and friend in USA during the later (October and November) part of this year.
