Dear Partner in the ministry,

Greetings from the Reformed School of Theology (ReST),



In God's grace even in the midst of this COVID 19 pandemic He has brought us almost to the end of this year. For this, we praise God for His unceasing love and care. Though it can be described as one of the most challenging years, God never withheld his blessing on us and in the ministry of ReST. When we look at the blessing that God has bestowed in the ministry it can be said that it is also a year of accomplishment in the ministry of ReST. Your prayer and generous contributions to this ministry made it possible to achieve these things, for which I cannot thank you enough. May God continue to bless you as we partner in the ministry. Some of our achievements are as below:

- We launched the B.Th program and also have Boys dormitory (Grace House) built, with a capacity of 24 students.
- Even in the midst of the pandemic, God provided us an opportunity, that we are able to do the following training. Apart from the regular MFC and B.Th training, we could also have monthly Bible studies and prayer fellowship for pastors, Elders and Deacons training, ITEM training.
- Besides all these, as the campus and Chapel are open to people who would like to use for gospel ministry. This year alone we have at least 10 groups of people coming for prayer meetings, gospel movies, and songs and having youth fellowship. This is something I considered a blessing for us.

Now, with the hope that God will continue to lead us in the years to come, I already prepared my monthly needs and one-time need and sent my

proposed budget for 2021 to the PMI. Listed below are one-time gifts projects and works planned to be taken up in 2021. Please prayerfully consider these needs as you prepare for the coming year budget.

1. **Construction of the first floor of the main building at the cost of \$20,000:** This half building construction has been sitting there for 4 years now without completion due to lack of funds. The foundation and the ground floor was constructed in 2016. The main building will have 8 rooms, for office, classrooms, and faculty lounge.



2. **Construction of Girls Dormitory:** Intake of girl students is not yet done due to the non-availability of the dormitory. I put a budget of \$10,000 for this dormitory, with a capacity of 10 students.

3. **Water Pump and Reservoir:** Water is another concern we have, as the school is located up in the hill. We have been trying multiple borewells but could not succeed. Now, the only option is to pump up water from

approximately a distance of 300 meters and store it in a reservoir. For this, I put a budget of \$7000.

Note: We welcome donations and gifts for projects in memory of loved ones. For a room \$3000 each (we plan to have 8 rooms in the main building), for girls dormitory \$10,000 and for the water pump and reservoir \$7000.
