REFORMED SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY: MINISTRIES UPDATE 2021

1. Pastors Payers Fellowship: One important ministry of ReST is to connect with pastors who are in the field. So far we are able to do this by organizing Pastors Prayer Fellowship once every month. ReST has provided perfect venue for such fellowship. Once in every month pastors under the Presbyterian church in India (Reformed) gathered together for prayer fellowship. At such gathering pastors shared their joys, struggles and burdens from their respective churches they look after. Joys were shared, struggles and challenges were lightened by praying for one another. Pastors took turn to lead devotion and Bible study, we sing together, pray together and sometimes shared a table together. This fellowship become a time to refresh, and to recharged spiritually and physically and all went back encouraged for the ministry. 2. Ministerial Foundation Course (MFC): This course was started in 2018 with an objective of creating theological training possible for lay people. The course was designed for one year in vernacular, whereby anyone young or old interested could enrolled for the course. For the past three years we have more than 40 students enrolled every year and about 30 students graduating each year. The course was also made in such a way that it is affordable for everyone. It cost only Rs. 1000, which is equivalent to \$15. This year we have the fourth graduation where 24 students graduated with their diploma. So far, we had more than 100 graduates, and awards were given to students each year in different disciplines, such as: Best Students (male & female), Highest score in Reformed Doctrine, Most hardworking student, Exemplary Christian Life, and Academic Excellence award.
