### **Mision Beta**

The incubator program with Misión Beta is making great progress. All participants are very active in their preparation. Some are pastors of small churches desiring to be developed and to plant new churches. Most of them are planting churches. And a few others are seminary students with a desire to be involved in church planting. As mentioned in our previous prayer bulletin, we would also invite you to pray for these pastors with whom we are walking along.

This month, please join us in prayer for Reinaldo Capparelli, pastor of a small church. Reinaldo and Marina are eager to continue serving the Lord where He might call them. They are praying to see what is their next place in ministry. Please join us in praying with them for guidance from the Lord.

### **Nuevo Avivamiento church**

During this winter that is being very cold and taking in consideration that Argentina is going through a very difficult economic situation, we started a new ministry called “Sopa solidaria” (Relief soup). We go out with a team on Tuesdays and Thursdays nights to deliver soup, coffee or tea, and clothes, to the increasing number of homeless in our city. We thus share the love of God and the good news of our Lord. NGOs estimate there are over 4,000 homeless people only in the city of Buenos Aires. Please pray for them and for our team in our effort to bless those that we can reach.



We will also have all August focusing on evangelism. Please pray with us for those who need to hear the Gospel. Now that we have set a strategy for assimilation, with the discipleship program developed last year and the leadership pipeline established this year, we need to focus more and more outwardly, reaching out those who need to hear the Gospel news. We will start this month, but we will focus on reaching out our neighbors throughout all year.
